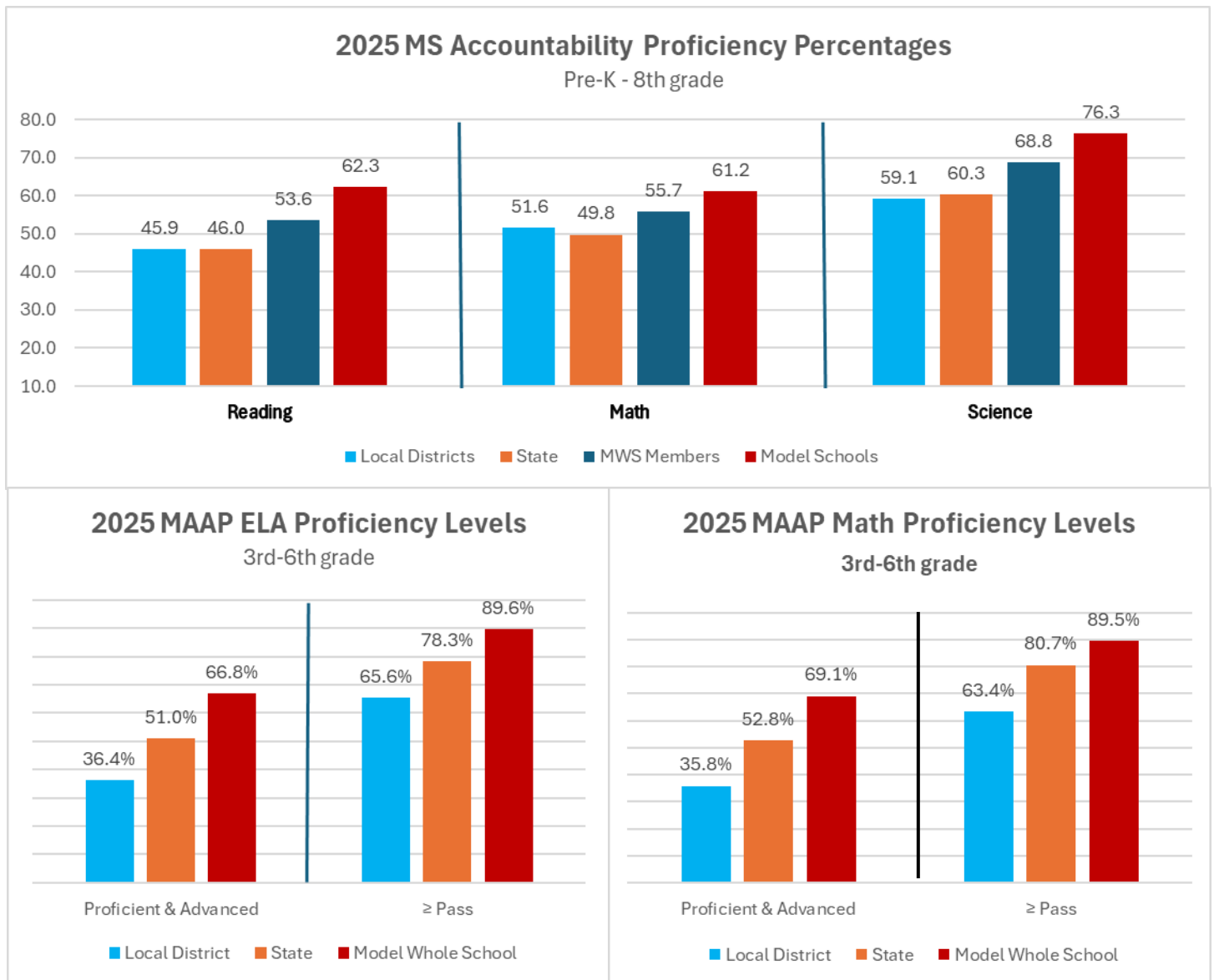




Mississippi Whole Schools FY25 Data Report

The annual Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP) data is used to identify and show improvement in student achievement. Analysis of this data indicates that students participating in Mississippi Whole Schools (MWS) demonstrate performance levels exceeding those of their counterparts at both the district and state levels.

As shown in the graphs below, MWS achieved higher scores in English Language Arts (ELA), Math, and Science.
